Statistical tools such as Karl Pearson's Correlation, Chi-square test, and One-way ANOVA were used for analysis. The findings helped identify key issues and provide suggestions to improve transportation fleet and cargo management practices in the organization.

- Operational challenges include fuel price increases, transportation strikes, and occasional delays.
